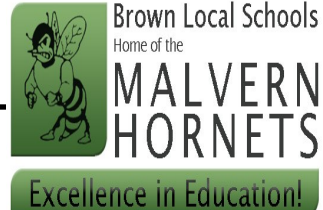

21st Century After School Program K-8 Stingers to START

Thanks to **ALL** of our families who have pre-registered their Brown Local student(s) for the NEW 21st Century STEAMM Stinger Program. As of Nov. 25, 2013 we have 65 students enrolled in our K-12 classes.

We appreciate your enthusiasm and support for this new venture in assisting our students with:

- Homework support for identified areas of need,
- Reading and Math enrichment.
- A STEAMM-structured curriculum addressing a multitude of facets

- including self-discipline and character building for life-skills and college and career readiness.
- Project-based learning.

The program includes special presentations, field trips, community service projects, hand-on engaging learning activities, creative construction and more, with a focus on 21st Century Skills (creativity, collaboration, critical thinking, communication).
